



# Legacy Scholarship

The MCBC Legacy Scholarship currently awards each year to individuals who want to further their education. The MCBC gives priority to students who want to attend a trade school or get a college or university degree that relates to the construction industry.

## Rules and Requirements

### A. Eligibility

1. Applicant must enroll in a community college, college, university or trade institution during the year awarded or next semester in the school's academic year.

(Preference MAY be given to those pursuing a construction related degree.)

### B. Application

1. The applicant is responsible for ensuring all of the following items are received by Master Custom Builder Council before registration deadline.

- Completed application form
- Two letters of reference
- Essay from applicant titled: Why I Should Receive The MCBC Legacy Scholarship. Essay should be 200-500 words and received with Application information.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

### C. Awards

1. The number and dollar amount of awards will be determined by the MCBC Steering committee. Maximum awarded up to \$2,500.

2. The applications will be reviewed by the MCBC Steering Committee. The Committee will consider each applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need.

3. Some restrictions may be made on the use of the funds.

4. Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon receipt of proof of enrollment.

5. If selected, you will be required to provide us with your Social Security Number for distribution of funds. We will contact you for that information if you are selected to receive a scholarship.
